** The Chronic Conditions Warehouse (CCW) team uses the state-reported dual status code (variable called DUAL_STUS_CD_MM) to identify beneficiaries dually enrolled in Medicare and Medicaid. We define dual coverage as DUAL_STUS_CD_MM = 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, or 08 for 11 or 12 months of the year, or until time of death. The CCW team uses the total number with any dual coverage (full or partial) as the basis of the counts for the second data table.

† The CCW team considered a beneficiary a full benefit dual if they had DUAL_STUS_CD_MM = 02, 04, or 08 for a minimum of one month during the year. The CCW team considers all other duals enrolled in partial benefits.

‡ The number of beneficiaries with Part D enrollment includes only those with Part D coverage for 11 or 12 months of the year, or until time of death. Note that this differs from the Part D statistics for CCW web Table F1.

▲ The CCW team calculates age based on the age of the Medicare beneficiary as of December 31, YYYY. If the beneficiary expired, the CCW team calculates the age based on the age at the time of death.

The CCW team uses the Research Triangle Institute (RTI) race categories to calculate the race variable.

NOTE: The application of different Medicare coverage restrictions/criteria will impact the size of these samples.
